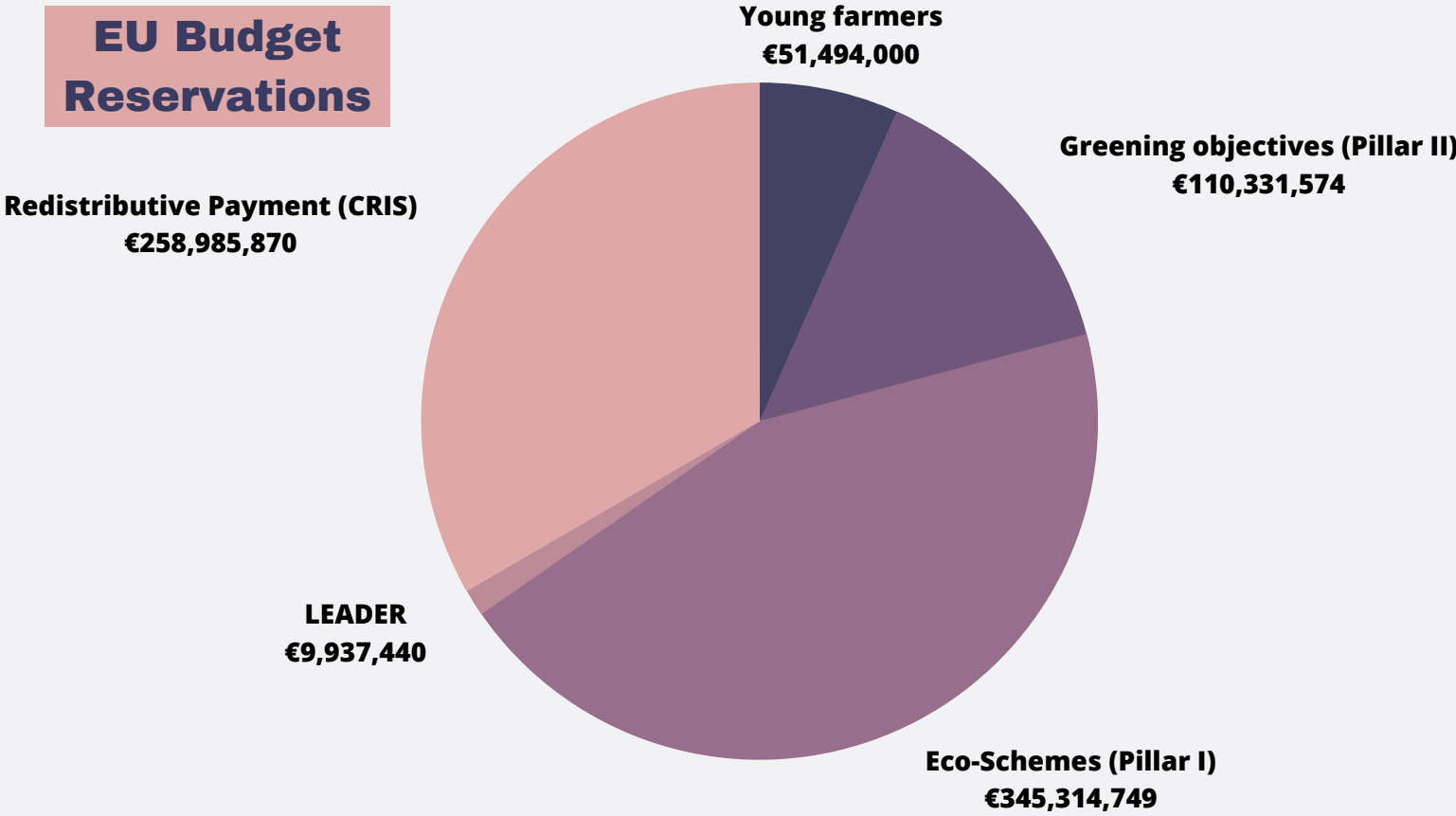
Key Highlights

Economics & Payments

Improve the financial resilience of farmers

- ~€259 million redistributed to small-and-medium farms over 5 years
- €17 million for protein production
- Coupled support to improve protein autonomy
- Diversification of production, on-farm energy production and energy efficiency

Greening

- 26% of direct payments ringfenced for eco-schemes
- 56% of rural development budget for greening objectives
- Increase organic farming to 18%
- 68.5% land incentivised to reduce emissions

Social Dimension

Focus on generational renewal

- Support for 620 young farmers + additional support per ha.
- Improvement of gender equality
- Projects on social inclusion

Innovation

- €500,000 to innovate apiculture sector
