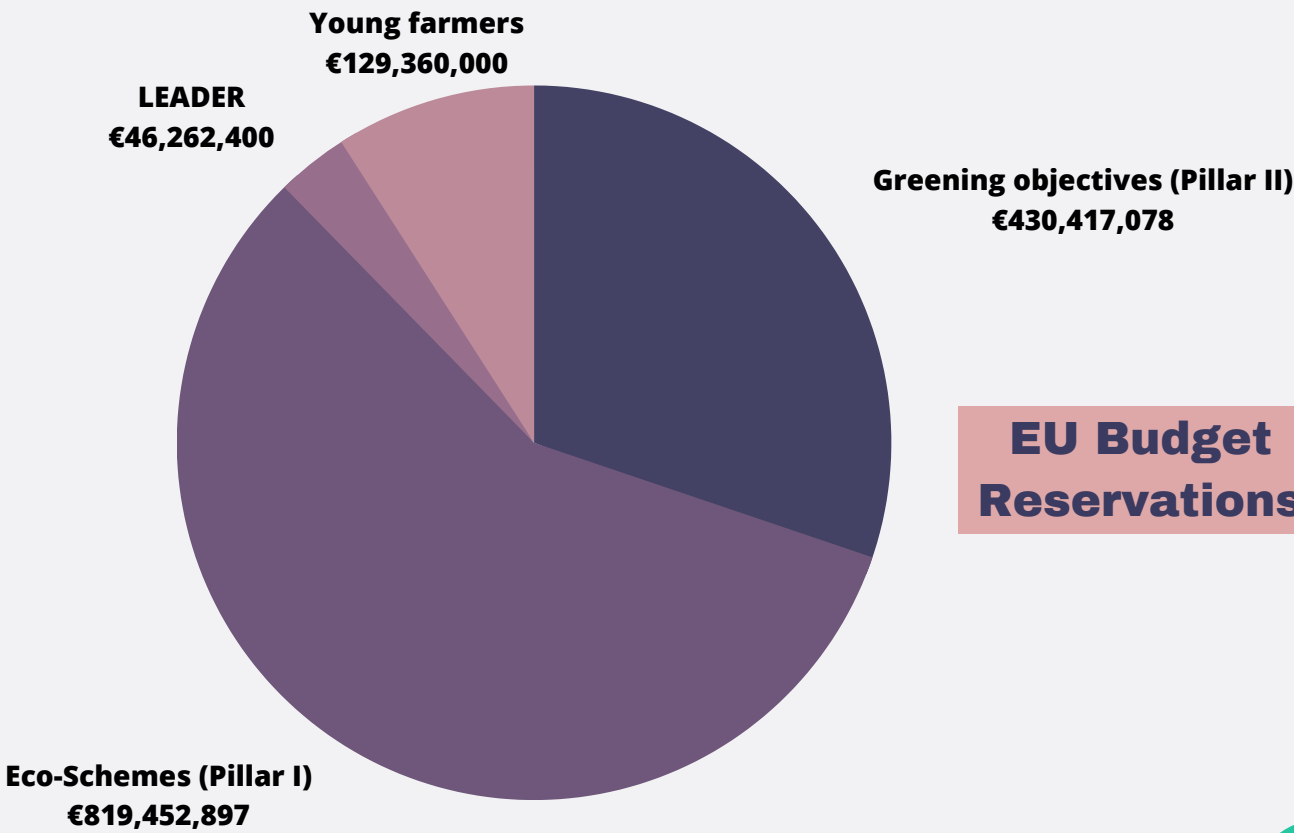

## Key Highlights

Denmark is responsible for 7% of the EU's production of pigmeat and 4% of the production of raw milk

- 98% of Denmark's land is rural
- Aim to reduce GHGs from the agricultural sector by 55-65% by 2030
- Denmark allocated no direct payments to redistributive payments

## Economics & Payments

New mechanism of financial support to be implemented to harmonise support per ha.

- Farms below average size receive 106% of amount paid per ha.

## Greening

- Support to ~403 000 ha. for uptake of organic production to double area
- 20% ringfencing of direct payments for eco-schemes
- €31 million to support afforestation
- 19% of funds reserved for farmers undertaking multi-annual management commitments for the benefit of nature and biodiversity
- GAECs covering 97% of the utilised agricultural area

## Social Dimension

Focus on generational renewal

- LEADER funds focused on job creation, growth and improving living conditions in rural areas
- 2,500 jobs supported in rural areas
- Support for 1,880 new young farmers
