Finland is proportionately the European country with the most forests

- 95% of Finnish land is rural
- 75% of land is covered by forests
- Geographical constraints - Plan combines both Mainland Finland and the Åland Islands
- 100% high-speed broadband by 2025

Economics & Payments

Focus: boosting profitability of a typically low-income agricultural sector

- 57% of direct payments to be used for decoupled basic income support
 - 19.6% annually, will be used for coupled support

Greening

National goal: carbon neutrality by 2035

- >35% of rural development budget & 16.5% of direct payments to be used for greening objectives
- 90% of farms to receive voluntary compensatory payments for greening activities

Social Dimension

- Typically family holdings
- 2,800 rural jobs supported
- 2,500 young farmers supported with start-up aid
- 98% of livestock units supported to implement ambitious animal welfare actions
