



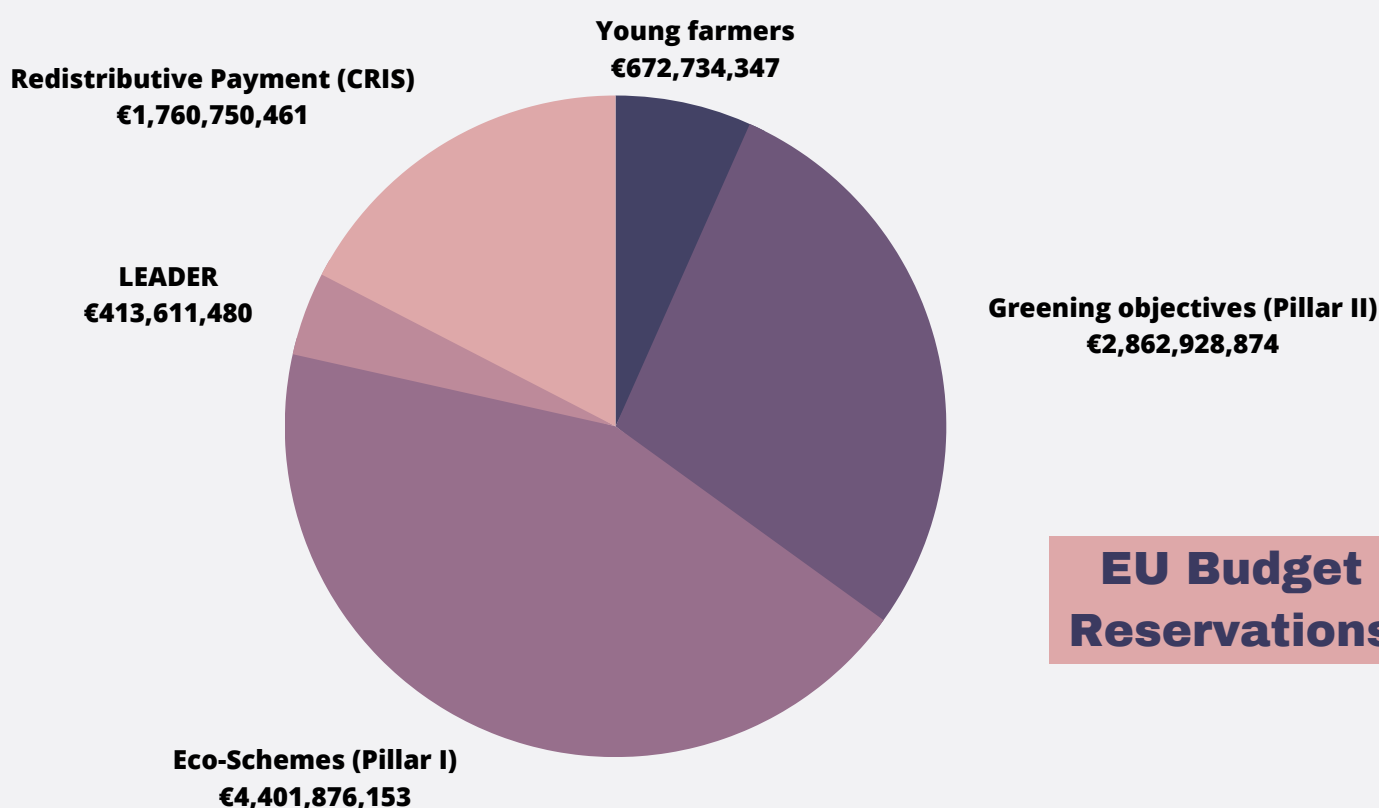

Key Highlights

Italy is home to the most geographically protected products. By volume, Italy is the world's largest producer of wine.

- 50% of the utilised agricultural area (UAA) located in mountainous or areas facing constraints.
- >50% of the population lives in rural or intermediate areas

Economics & Payments

- €17.61 billion to stabilise farmers' income
- €2,000 capping per hectare.
- 10% redistributive payment
- €3 billion to support farmers facing climate adversities (risk management tools)

Greening

The plan focuses on the transition of the agricultural food and forestry sectors, including by mobilising GAECs

- 80% of utilised agricultural land is covered by the GAEC commitments
- Boost organic farming to 25% of agricultural land by 2027
 - €2 billion invested
- €37 billion of spending to improve fertiliser efficiency

Social Dimension

Enabling access to farming for newcomers

- €1.7 billion for young farmers
- €741 million for entrepreneurs (women, youth, and long-term unemployed)
- €2 billion to animal welfare and antimicrobial reduction
