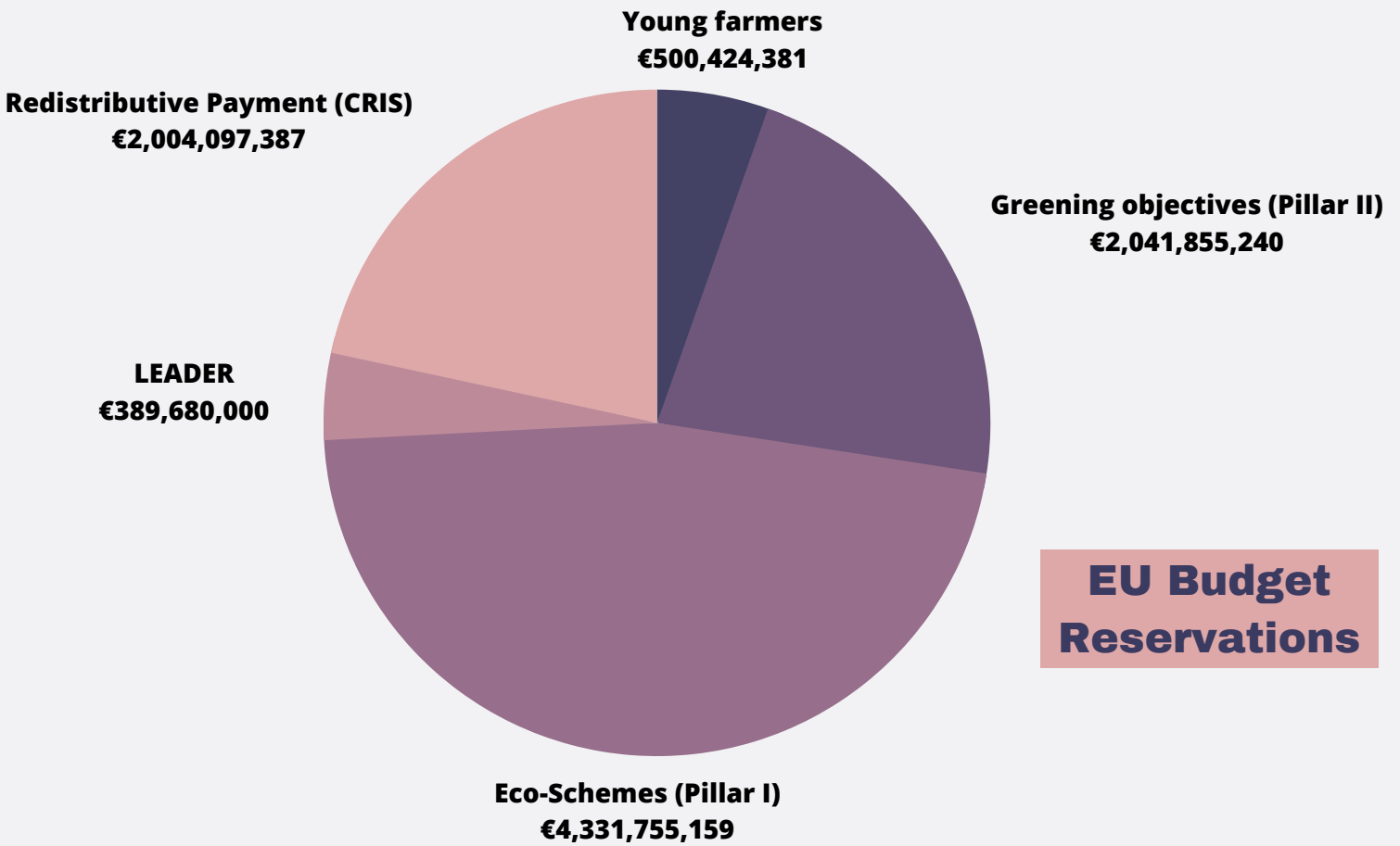

Key Highlights

Agriculture, forestry and fishery sectors in Poland contribute a total share of gross value added (GVA) that is twice as high as the EU average.

- 1.4 million farms in the dairy, cereals, pigs, poultry and horticulture sectors
- Focus on water, soil, air and biodiversity and promotion of sustainable energy

Economics & Payments

- All farms up to 300ha can benefit from an additional redistributive payment of €40 for each of their first 30ha.
- Support for over 2,300 investment projects in the field of energy production from agricultural biogas or solar power.
- Improve energy efficiency across 2,100 farm buildings.

Greening

- Doubling the agricultural area under organic farming and restricting the use of fertilisers and plant protection products in buffers.
- Focus on soil protection and sustainable production methods.
- Ringfencing 25% of the budget for sustainable funds.

Social Dimension

- €1.4 billion through a dedicated eco-scheme for animal welfare standards beyond national standards.

Innovation

- Developing 87% coverage of broadband in rural areas by 2025.
- Over 127,000 people will benefit from different forms of training.
